### **Windermere Town Centre**

Now that enhancement work has nearly been completed in Windermere, there should be an undertaking from Cumbria County Council, South Lakeland District Council and the other authorities involved that

1. There are some materials for paving etc available for repairs following repairs to services etc.
2. That any street furniture such as lamp posts, bins, seats etc that are to be replaced in the future in Windermere or Bowness Town Centres or on the road between are of a similar style to those used in Crescent Road.
3. That a similar enhancement scheme is started for Main Road, Victoria Street, Beech Street and High Street.
4. That the enhancement of Ellerthwaite Square is progressed along with the Library area.

About two years ago Building Design Partnership or another group was contracted to design new signage etc for Windermere and Bowness. These signs were designed some in detail with some public consultation awhile ago. What has happened to these signs and when are they to be put up?

The larger vehicles travelling along Main Road are having difficulty in manoeuvring to turn into Crescent Road. Therefore we thought that the one way in Beech Street could be altered to go from Main Road to Crescent Road.
