Public Exhibition

Design proposals for an environmental enhancement scheme to regenerate the economic and environmental wellbeing of Windermere will be on public display at the Marchesi Centre in Windermere on Thursday 14th June between 1.00pm and 8.00pm.

All are welcome to pop in a view the design. Members of the design team will also be on hand to discuss all aspects of the proposals which include the complete enhancement of Crescent Road, removal of street clutter, safer crossings for pedestrians, as well as improvements to the traffic system. Paul Holdsworth, the Town centre Manager, will also be able to lead site visits for small groups to identify the issues first hand.

If you are unable to attend the public exhibition on 14th June, details of the design proposals will be on display in the foyer of Windermere Library for 2 weeks after the exhibition.

The £2million Windermere Town Centre Enhancement and A591 Junction Improvement Scheme is only one part of the wider improvements identified through the Windermere Area Action Plan and the Windermere Master Plan. These improvements are being promoted by a group of local authorities and organisations including Cumbria Tourism, South Lakes Development Trust, Cumbria County Council, Lake District National Park Authority and the North West Development Agency.

I hope you will be able to take this opportunity to view the design, which has been further developed with the aid of responses received during previous consultation, and I look forward to seeing you on 14th June.
