The Windermere area is rich with fine examples of the historic Arts & Crafts movement of the late 19th century, and with the work of the renowned furniture maker, Stanley Webb Davies (1894-1978) who lived at Gatesfield in Windermere and Arthur W. Simpson of The Handicrafts in Kendal and Windermere.
